“ Prayer comes in all shapes and sizes and there is no right or wrong way to pray. We pray on our own and we pray together. We pray silently or loudly, gently or robustly. What we must do is pray persistently, bringing everything before God.

As individuals we may seek quiet places to pray, but sometimes we need to pray where we find ourselves. In countryside or car parks, in sea or supermarkets. It doesn't really matter as long as we are praying. But there are other times when we find more structured prayer useful and praying with others powerful.

One of those places and group of people could be your local church. St Sampson's, South Hill, where I am both Reader and Church Warden is steeped in centuries of prayer that you can palpably feel in the stones, as it is in many of our Celtic Churches. St Sampson, our Celtic namesake has a fascinating story of a prayer filled life and he achieved many amazing feats and deeds. South Hill is possibly one of the smallest parishes in Cornwall and yet is thriving, with a prayerful community at its heart. Our persistent prayers in this thin place are very definitely heard. Our congregation has grown and our links with the community have strengthened. We are an Eco Church and the environment features prominently in our prayer life along with the farming community which we serve.

As with all churches in Cornwall, we are part of Next Steps On The Way, which has involved much prayer and must continue to do so. For some this is a worrying and challenging process of big change and it may seem that other people's prayers are answered and not our own. But we must have faith that God is listening to all our prayers as we discern the way forward. However, It is not wrong to challenge where we think the plan is not of God and we all must seek God's guidance and discern God's will in this process to arrive at a God given conclusion. Indeed, challenging assumptions is part of growing in faith, asking questions helps us see more clearly, or changes our mind-set.

Wherever you are, whatever you are involved in, it is vital that you pray for your local community your deanery and our diocese, our country and world.

There is so much that needs praying for.”

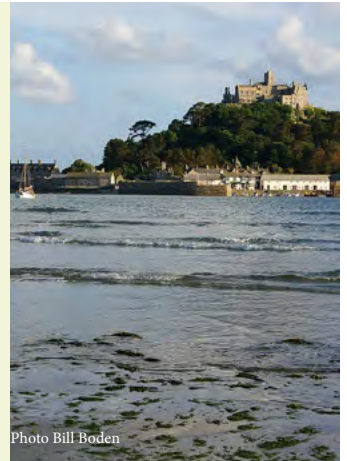

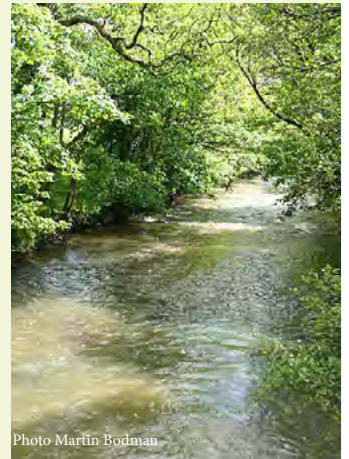
